Puppy - *for dogs of more than six months of age but not exceeding 18 months on the day of the test*

Novice Dog / Novice Handler - *neither dog nor handler to have won an award at a Field Trial or Working Test with the exception of Puppy/ Special Puppy or an award, other than 1st, in ND/NH*

Novice - *for dogs not having won 1st to 3rd in an Open Working Test, 1st in a Novice Working Test or any award in a Field Trial including Certificate of Merit*

Intermediate - *for dogs which have not won 1st, 2nd or 3rd in a Field Trial or 1st in Open or Intermediate Tests*

Puppy, Novice Dog/Novice Handler & Novice in the morning, Intermediate to be judged not before 1:30pm

Awards - *Trophies to winning dogs. Cards and rosettes to 4th place in each class*

Entries Close - *8th April 2020 (postmark)*

Meet - *9 am for a 9:30 am start*

Tea and coffee will be available, with bacon butties on arrival in the morning
