The day will be divided into two parts; a standard training session in the morning and then in the afternoon, the option to take part in the WRA Assessment – this is not compulsory!

The NEFRA Working Retriever Assessment is the perfect way to get an understanding of where your dog is with regard to its training; what is working well and what needs more focus.

The format follows that of a working test, although in a much less formal way so is the perfect introduction if you want to compete in Tests at some point.

There will be 4 separate exercises to be completed each of which will be judged out of 20; the pass mark will be decided by the assessors, on the day.
