Puppy – For dogs of more than 6 months of age but not exceeding 18 months on the day of the Test

NDNH – Neither dog nor handler to have won an award at a Field Trial or Working Test with the exception of Puppy / Special Puppy or an award other than 1st in ND/NH

Novice – For dogs not having won 1st to 3rd in an Open Working Test, 1st in a Novice Working Test or any award in a Field Trial including Certificate of Merit

Intermediate – For dogs which have not won 1st, 2nd or 3rd in a Field Trial or 1st in Open or Intermediate Test

Puppy, Novice Dog / Novice Handler and Novice to be judged in the morning.

Intermediate after lunch, not before 1:00pm

Awards: Trophies to winning dogs. Cards and rosettes to 4th place in each class

Meet: 9:00am for 9:30am start

Tea and coffee available. Please bring your own lunch and coffee mug. Donations of raffle prizes welcomed

Entries: Members and non-members £10 per entry.

Handlers may only enter each dog for competition in ONE class
